**How it works:**

1. The academic advisor will create a Personal Identification Number (PIN) for each student.
2. When you get your P.I.N you can now begin the application process. If you have questions there are tutorials and walkthroughs on the OUAC website.
3. The application is completely electronic but you should keep digital records of your payments and application process.
4. When you apply you will get to choose 3 programs. The base fee for this is \$150 and \$50 for each program afterwards.
5. Your application is submitted once the application fee is paid and a reference number is given.
6. You should print off a copy of your payment receipt and your reference number or keep a digital copy stored on your computer.
7. Your application information will now be sent electronically to each program choice.
8. Your transcripts will be updated by your academic advisor and OUAC will automatically send out your applications.
