How it works:

1. Log into ontariocolleges.ca and create a profile. You will need most of your personal information so you may wish to do this with your parents.
2. To create your profile you will need your student's number and Ontario Education Number (OEN). These will be provided to you by your academic advisor.
3. Everything is done online. You will not need to print anything and send it in.
4. When it comes to choosing your program you will have 5 program choices (no more than 3 at any 1 college) for a flat fee of \$95.00
5. Submit and pay for your applications. After this has been done you will receive a reference number. Keep this number for your records.
6. Print/ save a digital copy of your application and payment receipt.
7. All information will be transmitted electronically to the colleges.
8. Your transcript will be updated by your academic advisor and sent electronically to your schools by the OCAS website.
